PROGRAM: Tabitha Godoy - Families Plus

James introduced Tabitha Godoy, director of operations for Families Plus in Delta County. This organization was the recipient of a recent grant from Rotary. They have a remarkable track record of success with helping families in the county.

Ms. Godoy expressed appreciation for the community support Families Plus has received. They have been focusing on academics recently since school in the time of Covid is very challenging for their families, so Rotary's support for their tutoring program has increased opportunities for assisting these families.

She also gave an overview of how Families Plus works with their client families and the services they are

able to provide.

Club member John Coombe, who is both a mentor and a board member for Families Plus, also gave his impression of the organization and the work it does.

The organization currently works with about 99 families in the county. More mentors are needed.
